

2017 Election Deadlines

The Registrar of Voters' normal business hours are Tuesday from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Voters may also register in the Town Clerk's office any day during regular office hours.

Absentee Ballot Applications for the November 2017 Election are available in the Town Clerk's Office (860) 295-6206.

Voter registration deadlines and special voter registration hours for the November 7, 2017 Election

- **Mail-In Registration** must be postmarked by 10/31/2017.
- **Registration made through the CT Secretary of State's website** must be completed by midnight 10/31/2017.
- **Registration made through the DMV and AAA offices** must be completed by midnight 10/31/2017.
- **In Person registration** is available until Tuesday, 10/31/2017 at 8:00 p.m.
- **The Registrar of Voters office will hold special voter registration sessions on:**
 - Tuesday, October 31st from 8:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
 - Any person who becomes 18, is a naturalized citizen or a Marlborough resident after October 31, 2017 may register to vote in person no later than 5:00 p.m. on November 6, 2017. The Registrar's office will be open from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and from 12:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m., the Town Clerk's office will be open for receiving your voter registration card. Proof of age, citizenship or new residence in Marlborough must be submitted.
 - **Election Day Registration will be held on November 7, 2017 in the Large Conference Room, Marlborough Town Hall from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. allowing eligible individuals (residence in Marlborough) to register to vote and cast a ballot on Election Day. Proof of residence in Marlborough is required.**

All applicants must have completed the EDR process before 8:00 p.m. in order to cast a ballot on Election Day. Applicants in line after 8:00 p.m., will not be able to participate in the election.
