

Town of Marlborough Job Description

Title: Lifeguard

Summary: Seasonal position, generally June 1– September 3. Providing supervision and ensuring a safe environment of waterfront activities. Assist in the daily maintenance to the physical operation of the waterfront facilities and equipment. Must be available to work 20-40hrs per week and extended time off is not allowed, due to it being a seasonal position.

Supervision Received: Receives supervision from the Park and Recreation Director and Park Supervisor. Ability to work independently as necessary.

Examples of Essential Duties: (Includes, but is not limited to the following)

Essential Job Functions:

1. Guard all waterfront activities.
2. Provide surveillance during aquatic activities to help prevent and to manage injuries
3. Provide rescues as needed.
4. Utilize first aid and CPR and other emergency management services as needed.
5. Understand and implement appropriate response to changes in water conditions or weather conditions affecting the waterfront.
6. Assist waterfront instructional staff during swim lessons, as needed.
7. Assist in the management and care of the physical facilities and equipment in the waterfront program area.
8. Conduct daily check of area, bathrooms, and equipment for safety and cleanliness. Report any needed repairs directly to the Parks & Recreation Director.
9. Clean waterfront area daily keeping it free of hazards and debris. Including daily raking of the beach.
10. Serve as parking lot attendant, checking stickers, during scheduled rotations.
11. Other job duties as deemed necessary by supervisor

Minimum Qualifications: 16 years or older, American Red Cross Lifeguard certified with additional waterfront certification by start date of employment (estimated date June 1, 2017) Professional Rescue or Basic Life Support CPR and Standard First Aid.

Physical Exertion/Environment: Ability to work in various weather conditions, including extreme heat. Ability to rake and maintain waterfront and park cleanliness, lift and carry equipment as needed for set-up of waterfront – 50lbs or less.
