Connecticut Energy Assistance Program

CEAP continues through May 2023. People who qualify may be able to receive deliverable fuel assistance. Applications for CEAP typically take 30-45 minutes. Basic benefits towards your heating bill range between \$100 to \$600 depending on your income level, household size and whether there is a vulnerable member in the household. These benefits are usually paid directly to your utility company or fuel supplier. Households that heat with deliverable fuels like oil or propane may be eligible for additional fuel deliveries. CEAP recipients may also be eligible for matching payment plans, protection from shut-offs, and replacement and/or repairs for heating equipment and water heater(s). You can call the Marlborough Senior Center at 860.295.6209 to make an appointment and for more info.

Meals on Wheels

Medically homebound seniors (age 60 and over) may be eligible to receive healthy lunches from Connecticut's Community Renewal Team (CRT) delivered to their door. After referral's are placed, our drivers will safely deliver the hot meals directly to your home. Special diets and textures available.

The Marlborough Senior Center is providing transportation to those who are in need, just call the center 72 hours in advance to schedule your appointment. We are taking reservations for non-emergency medical appointments, essential shopping and grocery shopping.





Town of Marlborough Assessor's Office

State law provides a property tax credit program for Connecticut owners in residence of real property, who are elderly (65 and over) or totally disabled, and whose annual incomes do not exceed certain limits. The credit amount is calculated by the local assessor and applied by the tax collector to the applicant's real property tax bill. The amount of the credit that may be granted is up to \$1,250 for married couples and \$1,000 for single persons. Credit amounts are based on a graduated income scale. Application may be made with the Assessor's Office between February 1 and May 15th. Please contact the Assessor's office for more information.
