

2019 Election Deadlines

- Tuesday, September 10, 2019 a lottery will be held in the large conference room of Marlborough Town Hall to determine the order of names listed on the November 5, 2019 ballot.
- The Registrar of Voters normal business hours are Tuesday 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Voters may also register in the Town Clerks Office any day during regular office hours.
- Absentee Ballot Applications for the November 5, 2019 Election will be available in the Town Clerk's Office on Friday, October 4, 2019 (860)295-6206.
- Below are voter registration deadlines and special voter registration hours for the November 5, 2019 election.
- Mail in registration: must be postmarked by 10/29/19.
- Registration made through the CT Secretary of the State website must be completed by midnight 10/29/19.
- Registration made through the DMV and AAA offices must be completed by midnight 10/29/19.
- You may register in person until 8:00 p.m. Tuesday, October 29, 2019.
- The Registrar of Voters Office will hold special voter registration sessions on Tuesday, October 29, 2019 from 8:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- After October 29, 2019, any person 18 years of age, a naturalized citizen or new Marlborough resident may register to vote in person no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, November 4, 2019. The Registrar's Office will be open 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. or the Town Clerk's Office from 12:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Proof of age, citizenship or new residency in Marlborough must be submitted.
- Election Day Registration will be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2019 in the large conference room at Marlborough Town Hall from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. allowing eligible individuals (Marlborough Residence) to register to vote and cast a ballot on Election Day. Proof of residence in is required.
- Election Day Registration requires that in order to cast a ballot on Election Day, the applicant must have completed their application to vote by 8:00 p.m. Applicants who continue to be in line after 8:00 p.m. will not be able to participate in the election. All applicants must have completed the EDR process before 8:00 p.m. in order to cast a ballot on Election Day.
