

2021 Election Deadlines

The Registrar of Voters' normal business hours are Tuesday from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Stated below are voter registration deadlines and special voter registration hours for the November 2, 2021 Election.

- **Mail-In Registration** must be postmarked by 10/26/2021.
- **Registration made through the CT Secretary of State web site** must be completed by midnight 10/26/2021. To do this – google – CT SOTS and process with on-line voter registration.
- **Registration made through the DMV and AAA offices** completed by midnight 10/26/2021
- **In Person** until Tuesday, 10/26/2021 at 8 pm.
- The Registrar of Voters office will hold special voter registration sessions on:
 - Tuesday, October 26th from 8:30 to 8 p.m.
 - Any person who becomes 18, is naturalized as a citizen or a Marlborough resident after October 26, 2021 may register to vote in person no later than 5 p.m. on November 1, 2021. Registrar's office will be open from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. for this purpose. For the hours of 12 p.m. to 5 p.m., the Town Clerk's office will be open for receiving your voter registration card. Proof of age, citizenship or new residence in Marlborough must be submitted.
 - **Election Day Registration will be held on November 2, 2021 in the Large Conference Room, Marlborough Town Hall from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. allowing eligible individuals (residence in Marlborough) to register to vote and cast a ballot on Election Day. Proof of residence in Marlborough is required. There will be signs in front of Town Hall to direct you to the back door which is where the Election Day Registration will be held.**
