

## Questions about your absentee ballot?

If you are a registered voter and you have completed and returned a valid absentee ballot application, the ballots were mailed out starting on October 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Your Absentee Ballot Packet will include:

1. Ballot Box Insert (ballot and ballot box information)
2. Instructions for Absentee Voting
3. Inner Return Envelope (labeled Envelope B in the upper left corner of the envelope)
4. The **yellow** ballot
5. Outer Return Envelope (labeled Envelope C in the upper left corner of the envelope)

**In order to make certain your ballot is counted, please read & follow the instructions, which include signing the INNER envelope.**

The completed absentee ballot can be returned 3 ways:

1. Return the ballot using the US Mail
2. Return the ballot using the Official Ballot Drop Box located outside Town Hall (a very secure & convenient option)
3. Return the ballot directly to the Town Clerk's office in person

**If you wish to check on the status of your application OR the status of your ballot, voters can now access the Voter Registration Lookup tool on the Secretary of the State's website:**
