Cemetery Rules and Regulations

January 2022

1. All lots sold with perpetual care.
2. Grave space must be paid in full before or at the time of the burial.
3. Each grave space is sold with two (2) burial rights.
4. Each additional burial right will be subject to a fee pursuant to the most current rate.
5. The maximum number of internment's each grave space will accommodate are one (1) earth burial and/ or four cremation burials (subject to additional burial fees). Cremation containers when placed upon an existing burial vault must not exceed eight inches in height.
6. A winter service charge will be applied to all internment's requiring snow and/or ice removal and jackhammering as determined by the Sexton or his designee.
7. All mowing, grading, seeding, etc. will be done by the Town of Marlborough to maintain a well-kept appearance throughout the cemetery. Graves will not be mounded.
8. Flowers are permitted only in the front of the monument. Flower beds are not to extend beyond one foot from the monument. Flower rails, bushes, trees, urns, or benches are prohibited. Ceramic, glass, candles, lights, shepherd hoods, balloons, pinwheels, figurines or any artificial decorations are prohibited.
9. All decorations must be removed before the spring and fall cleanup.
10. Enclosures of ANY type are prohibited. Any tree, hedge, bush or other items which have become a nuisance to the maintenance of the cemetery, shall upon notice to the owner be removed. Upon failure to do so, the Sexton or town designers will have the power to remove and discard.
11. The Sexton or Town designee or any other person under their direction, may at any time enter the grounds to conduct operations of the Cemetery.

12. The Cemetery shall reserve the right to put in all foundations for markers and monuments. Foundations for monuments or markers or the placing of monuments or markers on the lot will not be allowed until full payment is made for the entire lot.

13. Lot owners must complete a Monument Installation Agreement. The Cemetery shall have the right to refuse permission for the installation of same.

14. One upright marker is allowed per double grave. Purchasers of single graves may not have an upright marker.

15. Cremation lots are allowed two flush markers not to exceed 8"x12" in size. All flush markers must be a minimum of 4 inches in thickness. Foundations for flush markers must be the same size as the marker.

16. Foundations for monuments shall be the same size as the monument base. The maximum width for a double plot is five feet.

17. All earth burials must be placed in a concrete vault.

Columbarium Rules and Regulations

No cremains will be inurned until niche is paid in full. A cremation certificate must be submitted at time of inurnment.

Purchaser agrees to:

1. Family or designee selects the Niche location prior to inurnment. Each Niche is 12 by 12 inches allowing up to two human cremains in standard containers to be placed inside. If, for any reason, the purchaser returns the Niche back to the Town, the original purchase price will be reduced to cover the cost of replacing any inscriptions. For this reason, no inscriptions may be inscribed on empty Niches.
2. All Niche lettering must be ordered and proofed through the Sexton, Assistant Sexton or Town designee. Standard Roman type and size shall be carved on all the polished stone. Inscription will be lettered by the town's designee.
3. Standard information shall be placed on the polished stone at the expense of the owner. This information should only include:
 - Name
 - Full birthdate (abbreviations where applicable only).
 - Full date of death in condensed script (abbreviations where applicable only)
4. No other decorations, words or phrases may be added on the niche. Any unapproved inscriptions carved on the Niche are not allowed. The party will be financially responsible for the replacement of affected Niches and the cost of replacement inscriptions.
5. No other objects may be placed on or around the purchased Niche at any time. They will be removed and discarded. Photos, verses and or designs will not be allowed.
6. Niche may only be opened by town's designee. The cremains may be placed into a niche prior, during or after a memorial service. There will be a charge for opening the Niche and will only be honored by the Niche purchaser or authorized family member on record.
7. Inurnments are Monday-Friday prior to. 2:00 PM. Additional fees will be charged for a Saturday inurnment. Service must begin prior to 1:00 PM.
8. Only fresh cut flowers may be placed only at the ends of the Columbarium at ground level platform and will be removed by the town designee's discretion.

Internment of Cremains Procedure:

1. Cremains will be inurned by Town designee
2. Cremains may only be placed in niches paid in full
3. Purchaser must complete and proof inscription with Town designee
4. Only the Town appointed vendor may inscribe the façade
