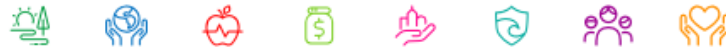

- 47% of points are rewarded
- Actions have different lookback periods
- Team of 50 plus reviewers- category specific
- Not all towns get certified on their first try
- Process, have to keep it updated

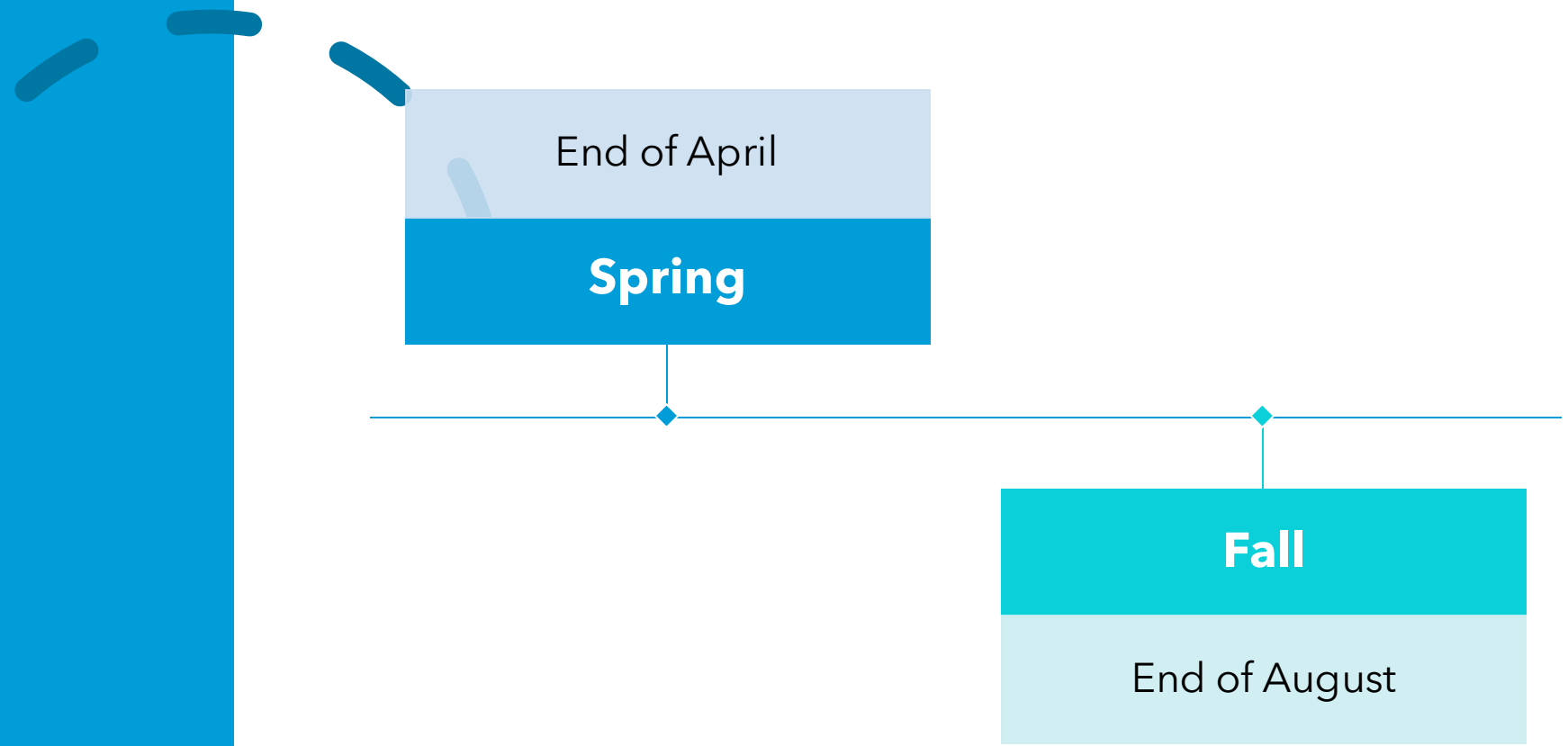
